- 1.0 Thank you for making available a copy of the Council's Development Contributions Policy.
- 2.0 Given that there are five Integrated schools located within the Council's geographic boundaries, the Association of Proprietors of Integrated Schools is grateful that the Council will not consider any changes to its current policy settings regarding development levies.
- 3.0 Given that Integrated schools are State schools, as defined by the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act, and subsequent Acts of Parliament, their contribution to the community supports the broad public interest of the increasingly diverse population residing within the Council's jurisdiction.
